That includes DACs and advanced audio processing, because you don't plug a standard speaker cable in here – you use a custom digital Ethernet-like cable, connecting to a source that can take in audio from your vinyl, streaming files or CDs. Best of all, this makes these speakers upgradable – the electronics can be swapped out for even better performance years later.

→ As the name implies, these speakers are all about heritage. 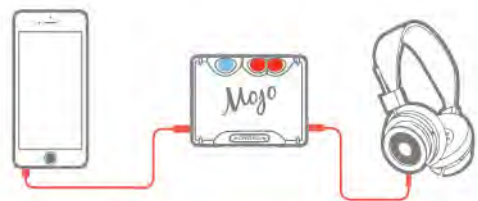

1 Acoustic Signature Invictus

→ 479 hand-constructed parts make up this imposing turntable. It's designed to be incredibly flexible and to support four tonearms simultaneously, so you can choose the right arm and cartridge for a particular album. The result is an impeccable turntable for playing your most-loved records.

2 Jadis Thalie

→ This turntable was built not just for audio quality, but for reliability. It has only four rotating parts in its mechanism, a synchronous motor means no electronic speed control, and a 50kg granite pedestal and 20kg platter fend off any unwanted vibrations. → There are two suspended platters in this turntable, which turn in opposite directions, with the aim of balancing the forces exerted in the unit, keeping the record as stable as possible against vibrations within or without the player. It not only looks really cool, but sounds absolutely amazing.

→ This elaborate turntable has a number of clever ideas, including magnetic feet that decouple the chassis from the surface to reduce outside vibrations, and a flywheel belt drive that keeps internal interference down. ClearAudio Statement v2

→ This colossal system stands 132cm tall, and weighs in at a floorboard-bothering 350kg. What you're looking at is a meticulous set-up that's like a Steadicam for vinyl, where the chassis is mounted on a gimbal near the top, with four oil dampers and an 80kg pendulum that hands down the middle, damping vibrations and acting as a self-levelling system, keeping the record turning perfectly steady even if the kids are jumping around next door. And that's before you get to the non-contact magnetic drive system and magnetic bearings. The result is possibly the best turntable in the world.

McIntosh MT5

→ The MT5 doesn't just look like it's come from a retro-future movie, it's made like it's sci-fi too. That glowing acrylic platter is magnetically suspended by two opposing neodymium magnets with just a ceramic shaft acting as a point of rotation, meaning there's almost no friction to interfere with your perfect vinyl audio. It's the same principle as the ClearAudio Statement on the previous page, and the tonearm also uses magnets for exceptional stabilisation. It makes for a stunning-looking machine, unlike anything else out there, and with McIntosh's nearly 70 years of audio expertise, it sounds just as brilliant.

This is industrial design as performance art, made to match your love of your music, and it's just incredible.
